Letter dated 29 August 2018 from the Chargé d'affaires a.i. of the Permanent Mission of Cyprus to the United Nations addressed to the Secretary-General

Upon instructions from my Government, I transmit herewith two documents detailing the infringements of international air traffic regulations and violations of the national airspace of the Republic of Cyprus by Turkey (see annex I) and the illegal use of closed ports by Turkish warships (see annex II) during the month of July 2018.

I also wish to inform you that the regime installed by the occupying power in the area of Cyprus that it occupies illegally issued three notices to airmen relating to exercises conducted by the Turkish Air Force during the month of July 2018.

It should be noted that Turkish commercial aircraft systematically use the airport of Tymvou, which has been operated illegally by the regime in the occupied areas since the closure of all ports of entry in said areas by the Cyprus Government.

In addition, Turkey continues to systematically harass civilian and military aircraft within the Nicosia flight information region via radio calls. At the same time, infringements of the Nicosia flight information region as well as violations of the national airspace of Cyprus continue unabated. Turkey's policy of persistently violating international law and breaching international rules and regulations is a constant threat to international peace and security that also has a negative impact on regional stability, jeopardizes the safety of international civil aviation and creates difficulties for air traffic over Cyprus and prevents the creation of an enabling environment in which to conduct the Cyprus peace process.

The said actions of Turkey, which has continued to occupy the northern part of the Republic of Cyprus since 1974, are clearly aimed at undermining Cyprus' sovereignty, consolidating the ongoing de facto division and upgrading the secessionist entity's status by claiming a purported airspace over the occupied territory of the Republic. In this respect, I would like to underline, once again, that there is only one legitimate Government in Cyprus, as stipulated in various Security Council resolutions (in particular resolutions 541 (1983) and 550 (1984)), in which the Council declared legally invalid the purported secession of part of the Republic of Cyprus.



On behalf of my Government, I strongly protest the continuing infringements of international air traffic regulations and the violations of the national airspace and the territorial waters of the Republic of Cyprus by Turkey and appeal for their immediate cessation. The Republic of Cyprus reiterates, in this respect, its call for all States to respect Security Council resolutions and adhere to the principles of sovereignty and non-interference enshrined in the Charter of the United Nations.

Finally, I would like to urge Turkey and the Turkish Cypriots to contribute to a meaningful resumption of the peace process, instead of focusing on undermining the sovereignty of the Republic of Cyprus and promoting Cyprus' partition through the creation of facts on the ground and the formalization of the status quo, as well as by seeking to politically upgrade the secessionist entity.

I should be grateful if you would circulate the present letter and its annexes as a document of the General Assembly, under agenda item 44, and of the Security Council.
