L11.14.01.2009. p.1.</p>	<p>Decree under the Articles 4, 5, 129 (2) and 260 (1) and (2) of the Civil Aviation Laws of 2002 to 2019 and given the Article 21 (1) of the Regulation (ER) no. 1008/2008 of the European Parliament and the Council of the 24th September 2008, as amended by the Regulation (EU) 2019/2 of the 11th of December 2018</p> <p>Due to the fact that the protection of the public health and the healthcare system are a responsibility of the Republic and aiming at the limitation of the COVID-19 coronavirus spread, the protection of public health, and also the prevention of possible health system collapse as a result of the spread of the virus, while taking into consideration the human resources and the material and technical infrastructure which will be necessary to possibly tackle the rapid virus spread, and because of the necessity to implement additional and stricter measures is imperative, in addition to the Regulations issued based on the Quarantine (Definition of Measures for the Prevention of COVID-19 coronavirus Spread), Decrees (No. 1) up to (No.15) of 2020 and without affecting those Regulations, the Minister of Transport, Communications and Works, exercising his authorities given by the Article 260 of the Civil Aviation Laws of 2002 to 2019 and the Article 21 (1) of the Regulation (ER) no. 1008/2008 of the European Parliament and Council of the 24th September 2008, as amended by the Regulation (EU) 2019/2, dated December 11, 2018, issues the following Decree:</p>

The present Decree will be referred to as the Civil Aviation (Defining of Measures for the Prevention of COVID – 19 Spread), (Amendment) (No 2) 2020 Decree and will be read along with the Civil Aviation (Defining of Measures for the Prevention of COVID – 19 Spread), 2020 Decree (hereinafter referred to as the “Main Decree”) and the Civil Aviation (Defining of Measures for the Prevention of COVID – 19 Spread), (Amendment) (No 1), Decree of 2020, which along with the present Decree will be referred to as the Civil Aviation (Defining of Measures for the Prevention of COVID – 19 Spread), 2020 Decrees to (No.2) 2020.</p>
<p>Amendment of the Article 2 of the Main Decree</p>	<p>2. Article 2 of the Main Decree is amended as follows:</p> <p>With the addition, immediately after paragraph (B), of the following paragraph (C):</p> <p>"C) According to Articles 4 and 5 (1) of the Civil Aviation Law 2002 to 2019, the conduct of all local flights are completely prohibited, from 24:00 Cyprus time on April 18, 2020 and for a period of 13 days, of the same airport or between the airports of the Republic, with the exception of the flights of the state aircrafts.</p> <p>Technical flights are exempted from the above prohibition, which flights will be allowed only upon receiving the special approval issued by the Flight Safety Unit of the Department of Civil Aviation of the Ministry of Transport, Communications and Works.</p>
<p>Entry into force</p>	<p>3. This Decree shall enter into force immediately as of 24:00 a.m. Cyprus time of April 18, 2020.</p>
