Speech of H.E. Ms. Suzana Bošković-Prodanović Ambassador of the Republic of Serbia to Cyprus At the occasion of the presentation of her credentials To His Excellency Mr. Nikos Christodoulides, President of the Republic of Cyprus

As I assume my duties as Ambassador, I remain deeply committed to working closely with You and your Government to further strengthen the existing bonds of friendship between our two people and further develop our cooperation in all fields of mutual interest that can be beneficial for the prosperity of our societies.

In closing, Your Excellency, allow me to emphasize my confidence that the excellent relations between our countries will continue to grow stronger in the years to come. In a world that is increasingly interconnected and interdependent, yet extremely volatile, the challenges we all face, whether economic, security-related, or environmental, require collaborative solutions.
