















Συχνότητα ανά εκατομμύριο πληθυσμού









EKPF


EKPF represents over **75 million** of people with kidney health conditions in Europe.

RAISE AWARENESS OF KIDNEY DISEASE

Kidney disease is a silent killer. Increase the visibility and knowledge about CKD is crucial in the general population, so we need to address CKD in EU policy, promoting education and healthy habits through educational programs.





RISK GROUPS

Certain populations are at a higher risk of developing kidney diseases, such as individuals with diabetes, hypertension, or obesity. Most people in these risk groups do not realize they are vulnerable to kidney disease until it has advanced. We aim to reach these risk factors to delay CKD progression.

PREVENTION AND EARLY DETECTION

Timely detection is essential for effective management and treatment. Most people do not know they have kidney disease because it often exhibits no symptoms in the early stages. We can make a significant difference in the lives of individuals at risk by identifying kidney diseases at their earliest stages.
